We expect everyone who attends our events to be familiar not only with the Bujinkan Guidelines but also with Irish law. We reserve absolutely the right to eject anyone deemed to be in breach of this agreement at any time from the seminar.

Regarding cancellations and no shows.

- In the event of the seminar being cancelled, we will refund participants who have already paid the full amount.
- If an advertised teacher can't attend at the last minute, there will probably be some training held anyway, but anyone who wishes may have their fee refunded.
- If a participant pays in advance and doesn't show at the seminar, there can be no refund. If you pay in advance and are unable to attend the seminar, please contact the organiser in advance to let them know. If you give us at least three days notice, a refund of 50 per cent shall apply. If you give us at least seven days notice, a refund of 80 per cent shall apply. (We keep 20 per cent to help cover admin costs.)
